**THEOLOGICAL STREAM - Residency: September 1- November 30 OR January 1<sup>st</sup> – March 31<sup>st</sup> OR May 1 – July 31** Participate in 2 Theological Studies Courses to allow oneself to be fully immersed in the classroom once again. The experience will allow for the opening of new learning opportunities, refreshing or enhancing of pastoral skills and building of relationship with current students and faculty. The remaining aspects of your sabbatical will be determined by you in consultation with the facilitator of the Flora Jane Baker Clergy Sabbatical program as appropriate to your own goals and interests.

**YOUTH EXPERIENCE: Residency: August 1<sup>st</sup> – October 31<sup>st</sup>.** Participation in the Future Quest Summer Youth Experience will offer an exciting and challenging experience for any Minister seeking to understand and minister among younger members of our churches and society. Future Quest, a 2-week community leadership program for 24 youth aged 14-17, is preceded by a week dedicated to training and preparation for the staff including the Clergy on Sabbatical. Both will deepen pastoral abilities with youth and young adults. **NOTE: NO UCC CLERGY HAS EVER APPLIED FOR THIS STREAM!!!!**

**RESTORATIVE JUSTICE \*if available in 2012 Residence May 1<sup>st</sup> – June 30<sup>th</sup>**

Restorative Justice is currently only available for the Spring/Summer of 2011. Waiting on Funding Approval from the Federal government (election delay). Participant will join in the intensive courses in the Practice of Restorative justice being offered in May by instructors such as Pierre Allard and Mark Yantzi. This internationally recognized course of study will allow the Clergy on Sabbatical to interact with both Canadian and International students.
